UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following O R D E R

- The petitioner invokes the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 32 of the Constitution to seek the following relief:
 - "a) Issue an appropriate writ/order/direction in the nature of mandamus directing the Judicial and Administrative Authorities to frame proper guidelines for just, proper and uniform implementation of the laws declared by judicial decisions of this Hon'ble Court in all judicial proceedings;"
- The petition is thoroughly misconceived. Article 141 of the Constitution stipulates that the law declared by the Supreme Court shall be binding on all courts within the territory of India. Moreover, Article 142(1) stipulates that the Supreme Court in the exercise of its jurisdiction may pass such decree or make such orders as may be necessary for doing complete justice in any cause or

matter pending before it and any decree so passed or orders so made shall be enforceable throughout the territory of India. Hence, the plea for formulating guidelines for the implementation of judicial decisions does not require to be implemented. The petition is dismissed.
