1. The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that the seat matrix adopted by the respondent/University is arbitrary and unlawful, in as much as, the candidates belonging to the reserved categories (OBC, SC & ST), who have secured more marks than the candidates figuring in the merit list of the General Category, have not been moved to the General Category, based on their own merit.
2. Issue notice. The learned counsel above named accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and seeks some time to file the counter affidavit.
3. Let the counter affidavit be filed within a period of two weeks.
4. Rejoinder, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
5. In the meanwhile, any admissions made after today in the LL.B course under the reserved categories, shall be subject to the outcome of the present petition.
