- B. direct and declare that fraudulent religious conversion and religious conversion by intimidation, threatening, deceivingly luring through gifts and monetary benefits offends Articles 14, 21 and 25;
- C. direct Centre and States to take stringent steps to control fraudulent religious conversion and the religious conversion by intimidation, threatening, deceivingly luring through gifts and monetary benefits;
- D. alternately, direct the Law Commission of India to prepare a Report as well as a Bill to control Religious Conversion by intimidation, threatening, deceivingly luring through gifts and monetary benefits;
- E. pass such other direction(s) as Court deems fit to control deceitful religious conversion and allow the cost of petition to petitioner.
- 3. That in view of clause (b) & (c) of the aforesaid prayer, the Respondent/State of Rajasthan is filing the present affidavit to apprise this Hon'ble Court that the State of Rajasthan does not have any specific legislation with respect to conversion from one religion to another. Although the State Government is strictly adhering to the guidelines issued by this Hon'ble Court, Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan laid down in different cases and the Centre.
- 4. That the State of Rajasthan is in the process of bringing its own legislation and till such time will strictly abide by the
