- 1. The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that the seat matrix adopted by the respondent/University is arbitrary and unlawful, in as much as, the candidates belonging to the reserved categories (OBC, SC & ST), who have secured more marks than the candidates figuring in the merit list of the General Category, have not been moved to the General Category, based on their own merit.
