Heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

In the counter affidavit filed by the respondent-State of West Bengal, shockingly, the State has relied up so called confessional statements of the petitioneraccused recorded by the police. To put it mildly, we are shocked to note that the State is relying upon

confessional statements recorded before the police. Another disturbing feature is that after examination-inchief of the PW-1 was recorded, without completion of his cross-examination, the Trial Court has proceeded to record the examination-in-chief of the second witness for the prosecution. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent-State, on instructions, pointed out that after examination-in-chief of five witnesses is recorded, their cross-examination will be recorded. We deprecate such practice.

As of today, we are not considering the prayer for bail only with a view to allow cross-examination of the two eye witnesses to be completed.
