allowed.

- (ii) <u>Applicant–Sarang Wadhawan</u> and <u>Applicant–Rakesh</u> <u>Kumar Wadhawan</u> arrested in connection with ECIR No.ECIR/MBZO-I/09/2019 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2019 <u>registered with Enforcement Directorate – Mumbai</u> for the offence punishable under Sections 3 and 4 of PML Act, 2002 in proceeding PMLA Special Case No.8 of 2019 and now pending before Designated Special Court under the PML Act, 2002 <u>be released</u> on bail on furnishing Personal Bond and Surety Bond of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) each.
- (iii) <u>They are directed not to leave the State of</u> <u>Maharashtra unless any justifiable reason is there and</u> <u>that too, with taking prior permission of trial Court</u>.
- (iv) They are directed not to threaten the Prosecution witnesses and allure them in any manner.
- (v) They are directed to attend the trial Court punctually.
- (vi) <u>They are directed to surrender the passport to the</u> <u>EOW/ED, if they have not earlier surrendered</u>.
- (vii) Learned Registrar General to interact with learned <u>Principal Judge, City Civil Court about : pending</u> <u>matters involving under PML Act and scheduled</u> <u>offences</u> (on the aspect of <u>availability</u> of staff and <u>deputation of requisite number of Judges</u> and connected issue).
