## <u>ORDER</u>

## Anil K. Narendran, J.

<u>SSCR No.29 of 2023</u>:- The Special Commissioner, Sabarimala has filed this SSCR pursuant to the directions contained in the order of this Court dated 21.01.2023 in SSCR No.23 of 2022 and DBP No.70 of 2022, regarding crowd management and other matters at Sabarimala, in connection with the Mandala-Makaravilakku festival season of 1199 ME (2023-24).

2. <u>SSCR No.36 of 2023</u>:- The Special Commissioner, Sabarimala, has filed this report, pursuant to the directions contained in the order of this Court dated 10.01.2023 in SSCR No.20 of 2022, regarding the steps to be taken to provide adequate facilities to pilgrims at Sabarimala Edathavalams, during Mandala-Makaravilakku Festival Season of 1199 ME (2023-24).

3. In the orders passed on 22.12.2023 at 10.15 a.m. and 4.15 p.m., this Court issued various directions on crowd management during the Mandala-Makaravilakku festival season

of 1199 ME (2023-24) and Registry was directed to list the matters on 03.01.2024. Today, these matters are listed before the Bench, after obtaining the orders of the Honorable the Chief Justice, on account of certain issues in crowd management at Sabarimala, which has affected the movement of pilgrims from various Edathavalams to Nilakkal and then to Sannidhanam.

4. In terms of the orders of this Court in SSCR No.29 of 2023, when the movement of vehicles to Nilakkal is restricted through 'hold and release' mechanism, vehicles carrying pilgrims will have to be parked at the identified Edathavalams or at the places identified in the order of this Court dated 14.12.2023 (passed at 3.00 p.m.).

5. By the order dated 12.12.2023 in SSCR No.29 of 2023, this Court directed the Chief Police Co-ordinator at Sannidhanam to regulate the movement of pilgrims through 'Pathinettampadi' in appropriate manner, without compromising the safety of the pilgrims, especially women, children of tender age and senior citizens, to ensure darshan to the maximum number of pilgrims through 'Pathinettampadi'. Further, when the movement of vehicles to Nilakkal is controlled by 'hold and release' mechanism, the Police shall take necessary steps to ensure that, to the extent possible, such vehicles are parked in

the parking grounds of Sabarimala Edathavalams and the pilgrims in those vehicles are provided with Annadhanam and other facilities available at those temples. In case such vehicles are parked <u>for a considerably long period</u> between Laha and Nilakkal, the Police and the enforcement officers in the Motor Vehicles Department shall conduct sector patrolling and such pilgrims shall be provided with drinking water and biscuits, with the assistance of the Executive Officer, Sabarimala or the Administrative Officer, Nilakkal.

6. On 22.10.2023, the District Police Chief, Pathanamthitta filed a detailed report, which contains the list of Edathavalams in Pathanamthitta district, including the places identified in the order of this Court dated 14.12.2023, where vehicle parking with basic amenities to pilgrims are available. The said list is extracted hereunder;

7. In the District Police the report of Chief, Pathanamthitta, it is stated that the pilgrims are not aware of the 'live status' of queue and rush and weather conditions at Pamba and Sannidhanam. Some of the pilgrims regularly make heated arguments with the Police when the vehicles are blocked, which can be avoided if the Travancore Devaswom Board updates the 'live status' of the queue and rush at Sannidhanam and Pamba on their website, which will help the Police to regulate the flow of pilgrims in a systematic manner.

8. In the order dated 22.12.2023 (passed at 04.15 p.m.) this Court directed the Travancore Devaswom Board to make necessary arrangements, if not already made, to announce the 'live status' of the queue, rush and weather conditions at Pamba and Sannidhanam to the pilgrims through public announcement system at Edathavalams when the movement of pilgrims to Nilakkal is regulated by 'hold and release' mechanism. Similar announcements shall also be made from the Police patrol vehicles deployed for sectoral patrolling at the places identified in the order dated 14.12.2023 (passed at 03:00 p.m.), where vehicles carrying pilgrims have been parked, when the movement of pilgrims at Nilakkal is regulated by 'hold and release' mechanism. The Chief Police Co-ordinator at Sannidhanam was directed to give necessary information about the 'live status' of the queue, rush and weather conditions at Pamba and Sannidhanam to the Executive Officer, Sabarimala or the Special Officer, Sabarimala, who shall pass on that information to the respective Sub-Group Officer/Administrative Officer of the respective Edathavalam for making such announcements to the pilgrims.

9. In the order dated 14.11.2023 in SSCR No.36 of 2023, this Court reiterated that in view of the provisions

contained in Sections 15A and 31A of the Travancore-Cochin Hindu Religious Institutions Act, the Travancore Devaswom Board has a statutory duty to ensure that <u>proper facilities are provided</u> <u>to Sabarimala pilgrims in Sabarimala Edathavalams/temples</u> <u>under its management</u>. The Temple Advisory Committees of the temples, which are identified by the Travancore Devaswom Board to provide facilities to Sabarimala Pilgrims during the Mandala-Makaravilakku festival season, have a statutory duty to render necessary assistance to the concerned Sub Group Officer in providing such facilities to Sabarimala pilgrims.

10. By the order dated 14.11.2023 in SSCR No.36 of 2023, this Court directed the Travancore Devaswom Board to ensure that proper facilities are provided to Sabarimala pilgrims in the Edathavalams/temples under its management, during the Mandala-Makaravilakku festival season of 1199 ME. The Temple Advisory Committees of those temples are directed to provide necessary assistance to the concerned Sub-Group Officer in providing proper facilities to the pilgrims. The concerned Assistant Devaswom Commissioners are directed to conduct <u>periodical inspections</u> in those temples, to ensure that proper facilities are provided to Sabarimala pilgrims.

By the order dated 13.12.2023 (passed at 12.00 11. p.m.) in SSCR No.29 of 2023, taking note of the issues on crowd management at Pamba and Sannidhanam on the previous days, this Court directed the Travancore Devaswom Board to limit spot booking facility to 10,000 on days when the Virtual-Q booking has reached 80,000. The Chief Police Co-ordinator, Sannidhanam and also the Special Police Officer at Pamba were directed to ensure that entry from Pamba is regulated through Virtual-Q booking and spot booking. The entry of pilgrims from Pamba without Virtual-Q booking or spot booking shall be restricted to the maximum extent possible. In that order, it was made clear that the above restriction shall be brought to the notice of the pilgrims through print and visual media. Thereafter, by the order 19.12.2023, taking note of the total footfall dated at Sannidhanam on the previous days, this Court permitted the Chief Police Co-ordinator, Sannidhanam, in consultation with the Devaswom Commissioner and also the Special Commissioner, Sabarimala to increase the limit for spot booking from 10,000 to 15,000, on days when the Virtual-Q booking has reached 80,000, when the footfall at Sannidhanam and Pamba are far below the holding capacity of the respective locations and the tail end of the queue at Sannidhanam is at a safer zone.

12. Today, during the course of arguments, the learned Senior Government Pleader would submit that yesterday (24.12.2023) <u>1,00,969 pilgrims had darshan at Sannidhanam</u> <u>through 'Pathinettampadi'</u>. In addition to this, <u>around 25,000</u> <u>pilgrims had 'civil darshan'</u>. Therefore, on 24.12.2023, the total footfall at Sannidhanam was <u>more than 1,25,000</u>.

13. From the submissions made by the learned Senior Government Pleader, we notice that, despite the directions issued by this Court to ensure that entry from Pamba is regulated through Virtual-Q booking and spot booking a large number of pilgrims, a majority of whom are pilgrims within the State, reach Pamba without Virtual-Q booking or spot booking. Since the Virtual-Q booking on most of the days has reached 80,000 and the number of spot bookings is limited, the Chief Police Co-ordinator at Sannidhanam has to restrict or even prohibit the entry of pilgrims without Virtual-Q booking or spot booking, when the footfall at Sannidhanam and Pamba has touched the holding capacity of those locations, in order to ensure safe and comfortable darshan to pilgrims having Virtual-Q booking or spot booking.

14. As already noticed, the total footfall at Sannidhanam was more than 1,25,000 on 24.12.2023. The learned Senior

Government Pleader and the learned Amicus Curiae for Special Commissioner, Sabarimala, would submit that a large number of pilgrims who had darshan in the afternoon of 24.12.2023, are still at Sannidhanam. Some of those pilgrims are remaining at Sannidhanam for Mandala Pooja. When the footfall at Pamba and Sannidhanam reached the maximum holding capacity, the movement of pilgrims to Nilakkal is being regulated by 'hold and release' mechanism, as a result of which, vehicles carrying pilgrims were blocked at Ponkunnam, Mundakayam, Pala, Kanjirappalli, Thirunakkara, Ettumanoor and Vaikom. Depending upon the outflow of pilgrims from Sannidhanam and Pamba and the outflow of vehicles from Nilakkal, the vehicles blocked at Ponkunnam, Mundakayam, Pala, Kanjirappalli, Thirunakkara, Ettumanoor and Vaikom are being permitted to move towards Nilakkal. The learned Senior Government Pleader would submit that the Police and the District Administration are providing drinking water and biscuits to the pilgrims stranded at those locations, in terms of the directions contained in the orders of this Court in SSCR No.29 of 2023.

15. When the footfall at Pamba and Sannidhanam reached the maximum holding capacity, the movement of pilgrims to Nilakkal has to be regulated by 'hold and release' mechanism.

Similarly, when the number of vehicles parked at the parking grounds of the Travancore Devaswom Board at Nilakkal has reached the maximum limit, the movement of vehicles carrying pilgrims to Nilakkal has to be regulated by 'hold and release' mechanism. At present, vehicles carrying pilgrims are not being blocked from 'Elavunkal to Laha' and 'Elavunkal to Kanamala' forest areas, as far as possible, since those areas have no street lights or shops.

16. When the footfall at Pamba and Sannidhanam reached the maximum holding capacity on 24.12.2023, the movement of pilgrims to Nilakkal was regulated by 'hold and release' mechanism, as a result of which, vehicles carrying pilgrims were blocked at Ponkunnam, Mundakayam, Pala, Kanjirappalli, Thirunakkara, Ettumanoor and Vaikom.

17. As held by this Court in **Ram Mohan Das v. Travancore Devaswom Board [1975 KLT 55]** the Travancore Devaswom Board shall manage the properties and affairs of the Devaswoms, both incorporated and unincorporated, and arrange for the conduct of the daily worship and ceremonies and of the festivals in every temple according to its usage. The position of the Board in regard to the Devaswoms, both

incorporated and unincorporated, is analogous to that of trustees.

18. When the vehicles carrying pilgrims are blocked at Edathavalams/temples, the Travancore Devaswom Board, in discharge of its statutory duty under Sections 15A and 31 of the Travancore-Cochin Hindu Religious Institutions Act has to provide proper facilities to the pilgrims, by providing them Annadhanam, drinking water, toilet facilities, etc. The Temple Advisory Committees of those Edathavalams/temples have a statutory duty under Section 31A of the Act, read with the provisions under the Rules (Bye-laws) framed under sub-section (3) of Section 31A of the Act, to render necessary assistance to the concerned Sub Group Officer in providing such facilities to Sabarimala pilgrims. By the order dated 14.11.2023 in SSCR No.36 of 2023 in SSCR No.36 of 2023, this Court directed the concerned Assistant Devaswom Commissioners to conduct periodical inspections in the Edathavalams/temples, to ensure that proper facilities are provided to Sabarimala pilgrims during Mandala-Makaravilakku festival season of 1199 ME.

19. Having considered the submissions made at the Bar and taking note of the issues at Ponkunnam, Mundakayam, Pala, Kanjirappalli, Thirunakkara, Ettumanoor and Vaikom, when the

movement of pilgrims to Nilakkal was regulated by 'hold and release' mechanism, when the footfall at Pamba and Sannidhanam reached the maximum holding capacity, we deem it appropriate to direct the State Police Chief to have a constant vigil on the crowd management at such locations, during Mandala-Makaravilakku festival season of 1199 ME, by deploying additional police force, if found necessary. The Devaswom Commissioner is directed to ensure, through the concerned Assistant Commissioners and the Sub Group Officers, that when the vehicles carrying pilgrims are blocked at Edathavalams/ temples, the pilgrims are provided with Annadhanam, drinking water, toilet facilities, etc. We make it clear that any failure on the part of the Travancore Devaswom Board in providing Annadhanam, drinking water, toilet facilities, etc. to such pilgrims will be viewed seriously, especially when the position of the Board in managing the affairs of the Devaswoms is analogous to that of trustees. The concerned Assistant Commissioners in charge of the Edathavalams/temples at the aforesaid places shall conduct an inspection, forthwith, and submit reports before the Devaswom Commissioner, with specific reference to the issues faced by the pilgrims on 24.12.2023 and today (25.12.2023). Those reports shall be placed before this

Court in SSCR No.36 of 2023, along with an affidavit of the Commissioner, explaining the facts Devaswom and circumstances. The Devaswom Commissioner shall ensure strict compliance of the direction contained in the order of this Court dated 14.11.2023 in SSCR No.36 of 2023, to provide proper facilities to Sabarimala pilgrims in Edathavalams/temples under management during the Mandala-Makaravilakku festival its When the pilgrims are stranded at the season of 1199 ME. places identified in the order of this Court dated 14.12.2023, they shall be provided with drinking water and light refreshments, with the support of the Police, District Administration or the Local Self Government Institution. Since the Virtual-Q booking on most of the days has reached 80,000 and the number of spot bookings is limited, the Chief Police Coordinator at Sannidhanam has to restrict or even prohibit the entry of pilgrims without Virtual-Q booking or spot booking, when the footfall at Sannidhanam and Pamba has touched the holding capacity of those locations, in order to ensure safe and comfortable darshan to pilgrims having Virtual-Q booking or spot booking.

20. Since a large number of pilgrims are stranded at various locations when the movement of vehicles to Nilakkal is

regulated through 'hold and release' mechanism, the Travancore Devaswom Board shall request the pilgrims at Sannidhanam, through the public address systems, to leave Sannidhanam after darshan, as early as possible, so that the number of footfall at Sannidhanam and Pamba, which is at the maximum holding capacity, can be reduced and maximum number of pilgrims stranded at various places can move towards Nilakkal and Pamba for darshan, today itself. The pilgrims shall also be informed through the public address systems at the Edathavalams/ temples and also through Police patrolling vehicles deployed for sectoral patrolling, to cooperate with the restrictions imposed, since the number of footfall at Sannidhanam and Pamba has reached the maximum holding capacity, and that steps are being taken to ensure that all the pilgrims have darshan, at the earliest.

In case any urgent orders are necessary on crowd management in connection with Mandala-Makaravilakku festival season, it would be open to the learned Senior Government Pleader, learned Standing Counsel for Travancore Devaswom Board or the learned Amicus Curiae for Special Commissioner, Sabarimala, to request Registry to list these matters before the
